FLIGHT MANUAL SUPPLEMENT NO. 5

PASSENGER PROTECTION SYSTEM

SECTION 2 - NORMAL PROCEDURES

Add the following:

2.1.5 Passenger Briefing

If the passenger protection system is installed within the basket instruct the passengers on how to orientate themselves on the seats and to operate the safety belts as follows:-

- (a) Insert the metal tongue into the plastic box until it clicks.
- (b) Grasp the free end of the correct coloured belt with the right hand and pull forwards to tighten.
- (c) Release the tension by lifting the edge of the metal adjuster buckle upwards and pull the belt back through.
- (d) Exit the safety belt, once instructed to do so, by pressing the red button on the plastic box.

The safety belts are colour-coded for ease of identification. It is important for the passengers to brace themselves even if the passenger protection system is being used. This system is designed to reduce the most extreme shocks incurred when landing in fast winds on rough terrain. It is not intended for the system to lessen the physical effort of the passengers in the landing phase.
